

**Faculty Positions  
Cardiothoracic Anesthesia and  
Cardiac Critical Care**

The Department of Anesthesiology at Weill Cornell Medical College is recruiting qualified candidates for faculty positions in cardiothoracic anesthesia and/or cardiac critical care. Faculty provide care for a variety of cardiothoracic surgical procedures including coronary revascularization, valve repair/replacement (including percutaneous interventions), aorta repair/replacement and electrophysiologic interventions. There is an active educational program for cardiac anesthesiology with teaching of fellows, residents and medical students. There are opportunities for research in cardiovascular physiology and pharmacology.

Applicants should be Board Certified/Eligible in Anesthesiology, either fellowship trained in Cardiovascular Anesthesiology or Board Certified/Eligible in Critical Care Medicine. Cardiovascular anesthesiology applicants should be TEE certified.

All candidates must have or be eligible for an unrestricted New York State medical license, and be committed to a career in academic anesthesiology. Academic rank and salary are commensurate with experience.
