

## Presentation Sessions and Deadlines for the PGA

There are several forums for residents to present their scholarly work at the PGA. The following table lists each of the venues as well as deadlines for submissions of abstracts.

- The Resident Research Contest is an international competition of clinical or basic science research of anesthesiology residents and fellows from around the world. The top abstracts submitted by May 1, 2015 are invited to submit a full manuscript by Aug 10, 2015. Select manuscripts are invited to present in a poster discussion format on Dec 12, 2015 within the program of the New York State Conference for Anesthesiology Residents and Fellows (NYSCARF). - The Scientific Exhibits, Poster Presentations and Medically Challenging Case Report sections of the PGA are designed to encourage discussion of the newest findings in anesthesiology and their impact on patient care.
  - Poster Exhibits consist of poster presentations of basic science or clinical research. While case presentations may be considered for presentation in this category, they are most commonly presented with the Medically Challenging Cases.\*
  - Abstracts submitted for presentation as a Medically Challenging Case are case reports that describe management of a particularly interesting or challenging case.\*
  - Presentations in the section on Scientific Exhibits are 3D presentations of information so that, in addition to a poster, there are other components to the exhibit such as a computer, a mannequin or interactive material. Submission includes, in addition to an abstract, a diagram of what will be presented.
- The Resident Poster Showcase, held on Saturday, December 12<sup>th</sup>, from 3:00 to 5:00PM in the Empire Complex, is part of NYSCARF. This portion of the meeting provides a forum for residents to network and discuss their work with colleagues and faculty from throughout New York State. The all-day NYSCARF program includes the Resident Research Contest, presentations relevant to the residents' and fellows' future career in anesthesiology and a hands-on workshop in addition to the Resident Poster Showcase.

Presentation of work as part of the Poster Exhibits, Medically Challenging Case Reports or Scientific Exhibit portions of the meeting does not preclude its presentation at the Resident Poster Showcase on Saturday during the New York State Conference for Anesthesia Residents and Fellows (NYSCARF).

\*The authors of the five best abstracts from these sections, as determined by the committee on Scientific Exhibits and Poster Presentations, are invited to present at a poster symposium on Monday afternoon of the PGA.
